Travel Ban under the authority of the Forests Act

Effective August 5, 2025 at 4:00pm, the Province of Nova Scotia has issued a Fire Proclamation – Travel Ban under the authority of the *Forests Act*. This proclamation prohibits entry into the woods in all counties across Nova Scotia for the purposes of travelling, camping, fishing, or picnicking without a valid travel permit. People will have mixed feelings about these decrees, so we are simply informing people of the decision of government. Pray for rain.
