

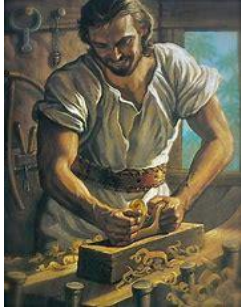

World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life - February 2

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord commemorates the presentation of Jesus in the Temple forty days after His birth. The Feast is also the occasion of the World Day of Consecrated Life, an opportunity for gratitude and renewal for all consecrated men and women.

In 1997, Pope Saint John Paul II instituted a day of prayer for women and men in consecrated life. This celebration is attached to the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord on February 2nd. This Feast is also known as Candlemas Day, the day on which candles are blessed, symbolizing Christ, the light of the world. So too, those in consecrated life are called to reflect the light of Jesus Christ to all peoples. The celebration of World Day for Consecrated Life highlights the gift of consecrated persons for the whole Church.
