

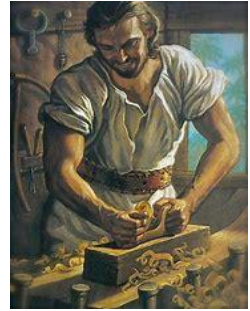

SCHEDULE

Celebrate and preach at the weekend Masses: Saturday 4 pm and Sunday 10 am.

Sunday Evening, 6:30 PM: HOLY HOUR

MONDAY EVENING, 6:30 PM: HOLY MASS, with theme of RECONCILIATION. Priests hear confessions after mass, exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and close with Benediction.

TUESDAY, 6:30 PM: HOLY MASS and HEALING SERVICE with laying on of hands and anointing with blessed oil (a Sacramental, not the Sacrament of the Sick). Exposition of the blessed sacrament, closing with benediction.

WEDNESDAY, 6:30PM: MASS and HEALING SERVICE with theme of the BLESSED VIRGIN MARY, exposition and benediction followed by a reception in the Parish Hall.

Beginning on Saturday, June 6th there will be a gift table at the entrance of the church where rosaries and articles from Medjugorje will be on sale.

There will be a love offering (collection) during the Masses on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday, for the Augustinian Healing Ministry. Cheques can be made out to Father Albert MacPherson or the Augustinian Healing Ministry.

BIOGRAPHY

Father Albert MacPherson, OSA, was born and raised in New Waterford, Cape Breton into a family of thirteen children. He joined the Order of Saint Augustine in 1962 and was ordained to the priesthood in 1974. He did undergraduate studies at Pasadena City College in California, Xavier Junior College and Saint Francis Xavier University in Nova Scotia as well as Villanova University in Pennsylvania before pursuing graduate theological studies at the Catholic University of America in Washington, DC.

After fourteen years of experience in spiritual renewal work, including ten years of pastoral experience in parishes in Ontario, New York, and Florida. Father MacPherson began full-time healing ministry in 1983. A member of Act Heals he has given healing services in Canada and the United States, South America, Europe, Asia, and the Caribbean Islands. Thousands have been helped through his healing ministry-spiritually, psychologically, and physically.
