Resurrection Cemetery is requesting that all persons who have a burial lot reserved (unpaid lots) to contact the cemetery office (902-564-6304) as soon as possible. At the time of reserving a lot-lots were reserved for a one-year period with the intention of making payments after one year. Currently these payments have been long overdue.

To have a burial lot listed in your name, and secure the lot for a future burial, you must have a pre-cemetery contract either paid in full or have monthly installments withdrawn from your bank until the lot is paid in full. Reserved lots will remain in our reserve until December 15th, 2025. After December 15th, 2025 if you have not contacted the cemetery office to arrange a payment plan for the reserved lot(s), it will be placed into the cemetery inventory for future sales.


November 17, 1 pm St. Ninian Cathedral, Antigonish Mass and veneration of relics of the Canadian Martyrs and St. Kateri
